

RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN SELF- ESTEEM AND ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENT OF SECONDARY SCHOOL STUDENTS

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ABSTRACT

The aim of present research was to study Relationship between Self- Esteem and Academic Achievement of Secondary school students. The study was conducted on a sample of 391 secondary school students studying in government and private schools of Jammu district. Self-Esteem Inventory prepared by M.S. Prasad and G.P. Thakur (1977) was used to collect data. The collected data was analyzed with the help of Pearson product moment correlation (r). The results of the study showed that positive and significant correlation was found between positive self-esteem and academic achievement of secondary school students. A positive and significant correlation was found between positive self males with their academic achievement. A positive and significant correlation was found between negative self females and academic achievement. A positive but not significant correlation was found between positive self females with their academic achievement. A positive but not significant correlation was found between negative self males and academic achievement of secondary school students.
