

VOCATIONAL MATURITY OF SENIOR SECONDARY SCHOOL TEACHERS

ABSTRACT

This study examines the vocational maturity of senior secondary school teachers. Vocational maturity is the ability to make appropriate occupational choices that fit the subject abilities occupational interests and occupational preferences. The sample of the study comprised of 200 teachers (100 male and 100 female) from government and private school of Hamirpur and Nadaun district in Himachal Pradesh. Descriptive survey method was employed to collect the data. Vocational maturity Scale for teachers by Dr. (Mrs.) Meena Buddhisagar Rathod and Dr.Madhulika Verma was used for the study. The major findings of the study revealed that maximum of the secondary school teachers have above average vocational maturity. The male and female teachers do not differ in their vocational maturity but for the dimension knowledge about self, where female have more knowledge than males.
